ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Secondary Diploma equivalent to a Saskatchewan Grade 12 - minimum 60% average, with no marks less than 50%
- English Language Requirement IELTS overall score of 6.5 with no bands less than 5.0. Duolingo and other assessments are also accepted
- A security clearance, personal interview and/or medical may be required for practicum placements
- A \$140 CAD non-refundable application fee payable to Great Plains College is required for an application to be considered
- International students must successfully attain a valid study permit to study in Canada. Students from approved countries may apply through the Study Direct Stream.
