Reporting to the Program Coordinator responsible for Nursing and Health Sciences, the Lab Coordinator is responsible for the setup and of nursing and health sciences course labs, clinical skills practice labs, simulations, skill competency testing sessions and other identified laboratory learning experiences as directed by the nursing and health sciences instructors and Program Coordinator.

The lab coordinator will work collaboratively and independently to support lab activities with the clinical skills lab. Utilizing a sound working knowledge and skill set related to healthcare procedures, you support the smooth and efficient running of the lab on a day-to-day basis. This includes pre-lab preparations, setup, support, and clean-up with minimal or no supervision. This position is responsible for the routine maintenance of the simulation models and maintenance of adequate inventory levels. This position may experience constant interruptions, changing priorities, strict deadlines, multiple complex logistics, and moderate/heavy physical labour and requires excellent time management skills.
